REPAIRS Now done:- Yellow Metal stripped, 6 pairs of Iron diagonal knee Riders fitted to Hold Beams and fastened through the side with yellow Metal bolts the iron bolts to side arms of lodging knees driven out and replaced with yellow Metal, 4 Buttrock planks renewed on each side of <sup>the original being removed</sup> Teak & Eng<sup>l</sup> Oak, Main piece of Rudder renewed of Eng<sup>l</sup> Oak, new Main & Fore Channels on each side, new Main Mast, Foremast and Foretopmast, Caulked from keel to waterway seam and resheathed with yellow Metal on felt.
