Last Survey, No. 1617 Port Stockton Classed Gen 5/55 A for 2 yrs

REPAIRS of damage now done, 4 Roughtree stanchions on each side renewed, also 7 1/2 feet of rail in way of the same on each side new of Robert & Co.  
Three hold beams and two arms to A. 1, deck beams and one arm to A. 2 having been found defective have been renewed of Baltic Oak, wood lodging knees in way of new hold beams renewed, and those in way of the new deck beams renewed of Iron, one piece on each side fore & aft of hold beam waterway renewed of Baltic Oak, vessel caulked from metal line upwards and the floor of upper deck from deck house forward, a strip of deck next the waterways on each side renewed.


