## REPAIRS

Before this vessel was sold the outside doubling from the yellow metal to the gunwales had been scraped bright and the drifts of keel found defective round the nail fastenings and the apron had been split out being decayed - The new owners have fitted an apron of English oak with one new breasthook and two roof ports have been cut in the bows. The timbers where seen appear sound but as the above work was done afloat and not under our survey we are unable to certify
