REPAIRS now done :- Middle piece renewed to the beam before the foremast, and two beam ends amidships. Fore piece of keelson and the ceiling on the starboard side amidships piece. Three iron plates and braces to rudder renewed with metal. Vessel caulked from the metal line upwards to the waterway seam. Bowsprit and foremast renewed.

This vessel is reported to have been coppered in India, from the appearance of the metal and the Bls produced, we believe such to be the case.
