The Bottom, from the Sheathing to the Keel, spotted down at the Owners wish, the Yellow Metal being reported to have been shipped off in January/57. 4 Firebricks of Bottom on the Port side renewed on account of worm, the Ropes brightened and one additionally bolted. The Mainboard Louse Pipe and Bolsters renewed. Iron Hanging Lines to Upper Deck renewed, as also the Upper Puckle & Boace. The Ship painted from Keel over all, and the Yellow Metal renewed on Fell.
