REPAIRS

from Damage

Six rougher timbers, one shift of covering board, the main rail refitted and part new, and fittings introduced between timbers in the wake of the Damage - Main berthing also renewed one additional Iron Beam hook in two parts, scarfing across the Apron - the Vessel caulked from Wale to Keel, and six strakes of Boot top sheathing renewed on Felt. The Yellow Metal likewise renewed on Felt.
