REPAIRS

Of damage now done. Yellow Metal sheathing stripped off, Two forehoods of Wale on the port Bow renewed of Teak, the front of Poop repaired 3 broken bolts in Iron knees renewed, bottom caulked from keel to Metal line, also Planksheers and Waterways, Yellow Metal sheathing renewed on part Felt and part paper.
Two pairs of Iron diagonal Knee Riders added to the two foremost lower deck Beams
