REPAIRS

On the above named date the Owner requested us to accompany him to this ship, for the purpose of Annual Survey, as she was about to sail next day in Ballast for the Port above named. She appeared to have had a Coat of thin Paint laid on outside and between Decks, the Standing and Running Rigging, Stows and Hull appeared just as she had returned from her recent long voyage, the Hold was not prepared for Survey, and we had great difficulty in trying any portion of the Caulking, all of which was pointed out to the Owner, and that the Survey could not be completed unless she was placed in a Dry Dock, thoroughly examined, and all necessary repairs completed.

On the same day we sent a Notice Card recommending that the ship be put into a Dry Dock to cleanse and repair the Zinc Sheathing, Rudder hangings further examined and secured. Caulking above the Zinc Sheathing to be properly attended to, it being slack at several parts tried, the Rigging requires to be overhauled and the ship prepared for Survey inside as well as outside.
