REPAIRS This vessel was docked to find a leak, and when visited by me the metal had been patched forward below the doubling on each side, and the leak was said to have been found on the port bow, where the caulking was bad. I pointed out to Cap<sup>t</sup> Billingham who was in attendance the necessity of stripping several sheets of metal to further test the caulking, and the ceiling being very shabby suggested that the same be made good by piecing &c; and after the bottom was found to be, or made efficient then to recommend the vessel for a reduction of class to Ex. 1. black, and sent notice of the same to the owners on the same day. Cap<sup>t</sup> Billingham informed me that the owners had some idea of selling her, but if not, he considered it necessary to strip the metal and fully examine her before proceeding on another voyage which they would do. She has now left the dry dock without any further examination.
