REPAIRS now done, from damage done by deck-house being on fire, 14 planks of deck between the fore and main hatchways renewed of yellow-pine and metal fastened; yellow-metal stripped off the bottom and vessel hung in shores, caulked from keel to waterway-seams on each side, false-keel added and 6 pairs of additional iron riders fitted in hold, placed diagonally and metal-bolts, bottom sheathed with metal on feet.

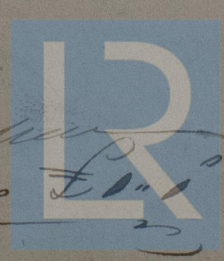
