Now done, the Yellow Metal sheathing stripped off, and renewed on Felt. Caulked from Kiel to Gunwale, three floor liders introduced in fore-hips. She is fit, in my opinion to remain Committee's Minute 23rd July 1858 as classed 13 A. 1.
