REPAIRS

Now done, - The Poop lengthened seventeen feet
 4 Beams added 8x6 of Red pine, the outside and
 inside planking, and the deck of the same properly
 shifted with the same material as before, the
 Beams fastened with one pair of staple standard and
 three pairs of iron hanging knees, a piece added to the
 back of Rudder, the Ship recaulked throughout
 and sheathed with yellow metal on two strakes of Felt
 & the remainder paper.
