REPAIRS now done. Line sheathing of bottom stripped off and the bottom caulked from keel to metal-line above tail plates aft and ring pieces forward as keel renewed of metal. bolts in scarps of keel renewed of metal. Iron bolts at hood-ends forward and aft, punched up and extra ones of metal added, as also in the butts forward and aft on the turn of bows and quarters new metal pintles and braces of metal except the upper one, all the iron bolts of bottom caulked with marine-metal, and the bottom sheathed with yellow-metal on felt. Nethermost pished on the fore-part.
