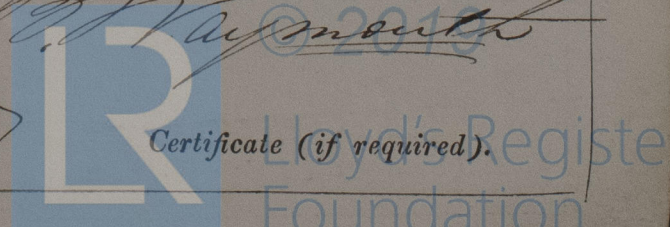
Now done, the Yellow Metal renewed on paper, her bottom and wales Caulked - She is now fit in my opinion to remain as classed 12 A. 1.
