REPAIRS At present under Special Survey in accordance with Rule Section 60 first part— Outside planking scraped bright from light water mark upwards including Plank sheers and Waterways. Bolts and Treennails driven out for examination & found good. 2 fore cant timbers on each side & 2 heel chocks of English Oak. Upper piece of Port Knightshead of English Oak. 2 short Tops timbers on the Port side of Pitch Pine. After piece of Kelson also a short fore piece of Pitch Pine. Iron bolter. 9 fore hoods of ceiling on each side of Pitch Pine one short ship of Port clamp of English Oak. 1 fore ship of Topsides on each side of English Oak. also one short fore hood of Wales on the Port side and one piece of Plank sheer of English Oak. 1 fore hood of bottom planking on the Starboard side and 2 aft on the Port side of Pitch Pine and English Oak. Two 1/2 piece of English Oak & 3 ships of deck of Yellow Pine. Vessel recarved and the conditions of Rules Sec 60 &c have been fully complied with
