REPAIRS How done

One whole beam renewed, one made good with a middle piece, and another one clamped, also three pairs of iron hanging knees added to whole beams, and two throat bolts of the others renewed.

The yellow metal stripped off the bottom the vessel being in shores. Listings cut out of wood sheathing at keel beam and woodends. Which with the rest of the bottom (not wood sheathed) has now been caulked, and the yellow metal renewed on part paper. 29
