The state of deck next the inner gateway renewed. one short timber on the starboard side renewed also one on the port side (forming a rough tree), both abreast of the fore rigging. one plank of deck next to the stake against the gateway on port side and a short length also on the starboard side aft. also replaced. The vessel caulked from keel to line to masts.
