## REPAIRS now done

The after piece of Rudder Keelson of Pitch pine fifteen shifts of ceiling in hold including one shift of timber strake four chocks in the frame two beam arms on the port side forward and a shift of waterway and deck thereat also one shift of waterway and deck in midships on the Starboard side one pair of iron knee riders added forward the Vessel caulked from metal line upwards one shift of sheer strake on the port side aft.
