REPAIRS of Damage now done, yellow-metal stripped off the bottom vessel hung in shores and caulked from keel to gunwale, false-keel renewed and yellow-metal renewed on felt, keels of dead, head-rails, cheeks and head-fastenings all renewed, rails and berthing repaired in various places, and the main piece of Rudder renewed of English oak.
 Repairs from rooming, - 10 buttock-plates on each side renewed of English, and Cantic oak, and plates partially roomed have been pieced.
