REPAIRS

Yellow metal sheathing stripped off. 2 lengths of upper deck clamp (26 & 39 ft) now renewed with Pitch Pine, 2 knees (hanging) wholly unbolted and 4 Iron staple standards unbolted at side & upper deck beam arms refitted and bolted. recast from keel to metal line and in way of new clamp fastenings and the bottom resheathed with Yellow metal over felt
