## REPAIRS

At present done through damage sustained, for full particulars see special report thereon.  
 Fore and after pieces of main keel renewed with English Elm and bolted with Yellow Metal also about 45 feet of false keel now renewed with English Elm one plank of garboard strake on each side forward and aft also one short plank of bottom next above the garboard strake on each side at each end of English Elm lower piece of bearding of Rudder now renewed and lower Rudder pinble and brace rebolted - 2 bolts (Y.M.) on each side in lower breasthook driven out and renewed, new face piece to knee of beam of English Gate. Vessel hung in shores recastled from keel to upper edge of Wales and the bottom sheathed with Yellow Metal over feet.
