## REPAIRS

Found this vessel sighting bottom, with her port side listed towards the starboard which side the metal sheathing was badly wrinkled forward and aft. The metal on the starboard side appearing fair, a sheet of metal being stripped above the keel ahead of the fore mast on the port side, exposed the caulking of the seam and butt very much, the latter being tried with a probe, penetrated the thickness of the plank. Recommended the owner to strip the keels to ascertain the general condition of the caulking or to strip the metal all off and caulk the bottom, which he declined to do. Sent notice card requesting the same.
