**REPAIRS**

Yellow Metal stripped off, seven strakes of doubling added on bottom (in continuation of that already on) and ships ending under iron chains approx about 10 feet from stem of Stanby's pine 13 ins brought on feet fastened with Yellow Metal dunnops and bolts, bolts driven on rings.

2 pieces of Sister Keelson on the Starboard side and one piece on the port side of E.D. Keel Yellow Metal bolters, ceiling additionally, recaulked from keel to metal line and Yellow Metal on feet.
