## REPAIRS

Now done, the Yellow Metal stripped off the bottom, the upper  
Course of bottom dubbed bright and examined, trenails and bolts  
driven out for survey to avoid shipping the metal when next specially  
surveyed - Four buttocks and two wale planks on the starboard  
side renewed, the buttocks retrenailed, and seventy-seven iron lodges  
like the bolts renewed; one pair of iron diagonal riders added  
extending from the upper deck clamp to the floors, under the break  
of the Quarter deck bolted with Yellow Metal below and iron  
at the upper part; the Kelson renewed with Pitch Pine, and  
an Iron Crutch and an Iron Hook added bolted with  
Yellow Metal - The Kelson bolted with 1 1/4 & 1 1/8 Iron - The  
Keel hung in shores and Caulked from the Keel to the  
second beam of deck inside the waterways - her bottom sheathed  
with Yellow Metal on felt -
