REPAIRS now done, 12 plates of wales and buttocks on the port-side, 7 d<sup>ts</sup> on the Star<sup>d</sup> side found badly wormed, have been renewed of Cantrie and English Oak. yellow-metal stripped, vessel hung in shores and caulked from Bul to the 3<sup>rd</sup> seam of deck next the waterways, a listing taken out at the waterway seams and renewed of Teak. Channels and knee of head re-bolter, one pintle re-bolter, and the yellow-metal renewed on felt, a false-bul fitted.
