REPAIRS now done, yellow-metal stowaged, vessel hung in shores false-keel taken off and Bulson renewed fore and aft of seat. The same through bottom with yellow-metal; 7 pieces of ceiling on the port bow, two lengths of timber-strake forward, and 3 pieces of ceiling on the Starboard-side renewed of Pitch-pine One floor forward chooved, and the first futtocks on the aft side of Mth Cross chooved, new-mast steps and hold pillars, 3 deck beams amidships renewed of Seat and English Oak. main hatchway Comings and pass of midship deck renewed, mizen-mast renewed, bottom Caulked, false-keel refitted and yellow-metal renewed on felt.

The Owner is desirous of having the mark (Y.M. over pth I.B.) erased from the Register-book, and we find by examination, and by the first-entry report that she is yellow-metal fastened to the 13 fut-water mark. Present Condition of the lower deck fastenings are of Iron, the metal sheathing being high covers the same, there appear to be the only bolts of Iron covered by the Y.M. good
