

# REPORT of SURVEY for REPAIRS.

No. 667 Survey held at London Date 29<sup>th</sup> March Decr 1859

REPAIRS Now done

The yellow metal stripped off the bottom, and the ship run in shores. two planks in the port quarter raised in (on account of room) one plank in buttock on the port side two afterboards in bottom and one plank in Quirkships at the upper part of the bilge on the starboard side with several three pieces in other parts of the bottom removal of 2 Calk. to make good the caulking of the bottom, the ship caulked from keel seam over all and the bottom resheathed with yellow metal on felt.

On testing the caulking it was found that it could not be made efficient without the above repairs -
