and a portion of the top gall^{ies} bulwark renewed - for more

The yellow metal sheathing renewed on Felt, the
Dupes Caulked from the keel to the Gunwale - the upper
Course of bottom had to be Caulked the second time
as it proved unsatisfactory when first tested -
