The yellow metal sheathing stripped off the bottom the ship hung in shores and cant keel from keel to plank sheer and the bottom resheathed with G M on felt.

The after length of poop plank sheer and sheerstrake on the port side renewed of boats a listing plank taken out of the deck to reclean. The waterway bolts seven rough tree stentions to poop had been renewed ahead.

The quarter galleries taken off and the planks shifted in the wake of the doors and filling timbers fitted in them.

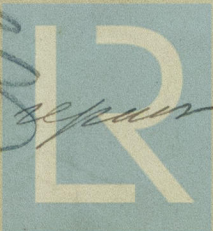
