REPAIRS now done. yellow-metal patched, partially caulked in upper works, and the windlass turned out of place overhauled, and repaired.

The rince-ay-head being found in a loose condition to which the bowsprit was jammed, and had at some time been secured by extra bolts of iron passing through the same and the main stem of the vessel I recommended that the rince be taken down and renewed, or reconstructed, and fastened in accordance with the Rules for vessels claiming a year for metal. The same has not been attended to but, iron jamming plates fitted at the sides of stem for the security of the bowsprit, and the rince-ay-head temporarily secured for the voyage.
