This vessel put back to stop a leak after part of the cargo was discharged, a piece of lower deck clamp on the starboard side in midships was cut ^{out} to find the same which exposed four defective timbers, (two being together). The timbers before and abaft the same being found good where they could be examined, this deficiency has been compensated by a filling worked between the S.D. waterway and shelf bolted vertically, the defective timbers pieced and a pair of straps $4\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{3}{4}$ worked diagonally crossing each other and extending from the upper deck clamp two feet below the lower hanging knee - & the lower deck shelf additionally bolted with iron between the fore and main masts - One hold beam arm renewed with Baltic Oak - The leak which was found in a butt under the counter (and covered by a lead pipe) stopped -
