REPAIRS now done, four strakes of copper sheathing at the turn of the bilge between the fore part of the fore and after part of the main channels on each side stripped off (22 sheets in length) and five seams in way of same recaulked and the copper sheathing replaced with yellow metal upon felt; the vessel recaulked from the copper line over all and the butts of outside planking under the counter additionally, through bolted with yellow metal. Mizzen mast renewed, mizzen rigging new of wire rope and the vessel rigged as a Barge - Windlass stripped and examined.

This vessel was stripped, caulked and sheathed with copper on paper at Whampoa in October 1858. Logbook examined.
