REPAIRS

At the request of the owner examined her with a view to her being raised to the Aired character. Found her lying afloat in the Surrey Canal, some planks on the Port side defective, and the shifting of new planks on both sides short and badly shifted & arranged, and fastened with spike nails; butts wide and caulking slack measured depth of hold and found it 13 ft. 8 in. with no hold beams, and the shelf piece of hold cut off at the bow & quarter; some of the upper deck beams also insufficiently scarphed - gave verbal recommendations to the owner on the 14th September and notice card as follows, on the 20th Sept.^r, recommending "that a clamp or shelf be added along the main body in a line with the shelf at present at the ends of the Vessel, the same to be properly bolted thro' the outside planking and that from 6 to 8 hold beams be introduced and efficiently secured to the said shelf & ship side also the defective bottom planking removed & caulked as verbally pointed out to you on the 14th Sept. before."
