REPAIRS

at present all the yellow metal sheathing stripped off Part of the wood sheathing and felt (which was put on in 1852) stripped off the Hull seams and Strake of bottom next to it and at the bilge and over the hooding and forward rafe and the Caulking of main bottom in all these parts found hard & good - the uncovered seams have been again sheathed with wood on felt and all the ~~the~~ seams of wood sheathing caulked and bottom resheathed with yellow metal - new after length of false keel fitted -
