Midclass lining taken off and the main piece found defective, now renewed with English Oak, new Mizen Mast & Cross Jack Yard also new Ripping of loire Yellow metal stripped off, caulked all over and the bottom resheathed with Yellow metal on paper at China in June 1860 the bills for which have been produced and examined
