REPAIRS now done, yellow-metal stripped, greenails at the bilges in 12 strakes, from lower part of thick stuff over floors up to deck, and extending from the fore-mast as far aft as the mizen-mast renewed, part of a strake of 4" teak and oak now added next below floor-head stuff on each side extending from forward to the main-mast, lower part of apron renewed of teak, and stemson piece renewed of English oak, 3 iron hooks taken down, refitted and metal bolted, Caulked from stem to upper part of wales and yellow-metal renewed on felt.


