REPAIRS Now done, the Yellow Metal sheathing stripped off the bottom, the fore piece of keel, the Carboard fore board of Carboard, and a listing adjoining, also the Gripe, renewed with Elm, the keel trimmed up two inches and a $\frac{1}{2}$ fold keel added fore and aft, the Quarter Galleries taken off and dispensed with, Quarter Pieces introduced in their place, the Shefts of Planks of the Prop drift in wake of the Gallery door shefted with Teak, all the Main & Topgallant bulwark renewed. She has been hung in shores and Caulked from the keel to the wales, the butts of the Topsides, the Stanchions and the upper deck, her bottom resheathed with Yellow Metal on Paper.
