REPAIRS now done to complete the requirements of the rule Sec 60 for A 1 in Regd. (Please see Owners letter requesting to be allowed to do so) A strake of topside planks on each side and two buttock planks taken out for survey of frame and found good, the planks now renewed of American Oak, upper works scraped bright and fastenings fully examined and found good. Caulked from upper part of wood sheathing to the waterway seams, new main mast and cheere fitted to the foremast, new main rail to knee of head on the port side, Chain plates shipped to fore & main mast, bedding repaired where necessary.
