REPAIRS

Now done, ten Roughtree stanchions renewed with English Oak, the Windlafs stripped, and found good, two planks each side next the waterway renewed; the whole of the Hog Kelson renewed with Green heart 8 x 13 - three pairs of Knee Riders and one Iron Breasthook added; the upper deck Clamps additionally bolted with 3/4 Iron thro' bolts, and the Hold Beam Clamps with 3/4 x 11 Iron bolts about 150 in number each side; her fore and main masts renewed and she has been altered to a Barge from a ship - she has been caulked from the belt line to the second seam of deck inside the waterway including her Roughtree stanchions -
