REPAIRS Now done, five shifts of Ceiling on the port side and one on the Starboard side, and the fore piece of Kelson renewed with Pitch Pine; fifteen strakes of upper deck on the Starboard and thirteen strakes on the port side renewed with yellow pine extending from the Poop forward. the poop Cant new of Pitch Pine, a pair of Iron hanging knees added to the breast beam of the Poop - an Iron hook and two wood stumps of English Oak introduced in lieu of defective wood Hook in the 'tween decks; the buttricks brightened and together with the lower deck binding bolts examined, the Cant keels forward have been additionally bolted, she has been hung in shores and Caulked throughout - and her bottom sheathed with yellow metal on felt - Her Chain Cables have been ranged, examined, and found good and sufficient - she had been supplied with a warp
