REPAIRS

An inner Waterway of Battie fir, caued into the planks next the main Waterway extending into poop and forecastle, in gout bolted at and between each roughened stention with Yellow metal the throat bolt in the beam-arm of each upper deck hanging knee being renewed thro' the new inner water way with iron plugged over, which has been pointed out to the Master & owner as objectionable to the rule sec 46.
