REPAIRS

Yellow Metal stripped off, the iron bolts under upper course of Iron metal found wasted now taken out and renewed with Iron metal, 1 pair of iron Hanging knees added to upper deck Beams, a Beam introduced of Ed Teak across main Hatch fore side of Half beam & connected to side by iron Hanging knees, hung in shores to caulk keel seam, caulked from keel to 3rd beam of deck next the Waterways and bottom remetalled on feet
