REPAIRS

The gillaring stroke on keelson from the stemson to a little before the main hatch, and from the aft side of main hatch to shaft after hatch including the mast steps (fore & main) renewed with pitch pine. Two iron hanging knees on each side added to hold beams. Where the riders are broken in the thwart, one pointer forward renewed and an iron breasthook fitted thereon in place of one of wood. Defects cut out of rider keelson and repaired with pieces.
