REPAIRS

Yellow metal sheathing stripped to the light water line and the outside planking brightened from thence to Waterway seam bolts and trenails driven out for inspection and found good. Stems knee found defective taken out and renewed with English Oak. The two lower Breasthooks removed to renew Stems knee refitted and rebolts. Studlar unshipped, wood linings stripped off the main piece examined and found good, recaulked from where stripped to gunwall and new metal wrought on felt over part stripped - new main & Mizzen Masts, main Topsail Yard & some smaller spars a new Stawser & a stream Chain now added to complete required stores
