## REPAIRS

Yellow metal stripped off. outside planking brightened from light water line upwards including Plank sheers and Waterways. Bolts and treenails driven out for inspection & found good. 2 planks of each buttock taken out and renewed with Pitch Pine. one plank of fore-castle drift on each side renewed with Baltic Red pine. one plank of timber strake new of American Oak and one plank of ceiling next the timber strake new of Baltic Red pine. Treenails recaulked from G. Metal line to bilges also recaulked from keel to gunwale. Windlass linings taken off the main piece examined & found good. bottom unmetalled on felt.
