REPAIRS Now done, the bottom and deck Caulked, and the bottom resheathed with Yellow Metal on Paper - three throat bolts of hanging knees to the Hold Beams and six Clamp bolts on each side renewed with Yellow Metal - the Windlass examined and found good, the body inclined - and a portion of a stroke of deck each side next the waterway renewed -
