REPAIRS At present under Special Survey Rule Sec 54; the whole of the yellow metal and wood sheathing stripped off, the outside planking from the waterway seam to the light water mark, trenails and bolts driven out for inspection also seven keelson bolts and found good — One plank of topside, two of buttock and one of wales on Starboard and one of sheerstrake ^{and} one of buttock on port side renewed with Pitch Pine — Main piece of rudder renewed with English Oak Windlass stripped examined and found good, Throat and second bolts of knee riders renewed with Iron, recaulked through-out, the wales resheathed with Pine on Felt and the bottom resheathed with Copper on Felt —
