REPAIRS

At this date stripped off the Yellow Metal Sheathing.
 Renewed six lengths of lower hold ceiling forward on the Starb^d.
 side, one on the Larb^d. — On the Starb^d side aft, three in No. one
 on the Port side, and all of East India Seal. Removed most or all
 of the air battens below hold beams. Timbers proved sound.
 Gave her a New Paul bitt. Caulked the outside from Keel to Gunnel
 Resheathed with Yellow Metal on felt, and general overhaul.
