REPAIRS

Found this Vessel as follows. viz outside at the fore broader ends several of the bolts started. Seams of planking wide, fore Gripe split. The lower strake of the doubling planks on the wales forced off from its work with the vacuum & caulking. - and the keel bottom & hogged. -

Inside also at the fore end, the two lower iron hooks both of them broken most or all of the ceiling planks in a decay'd state and in bad condition with signs of leakage, some of the timbers soft and defective. Recommended as per Notice Card "The timbers found soft and defective be further examined and ceiling planks removed for the above purpose and the ship prepared for further survey" On the 10<sup>th</sup> pointed out more ceiling planks and the keel at heel of stem to come out, and all defects seen. - and advised the introduction of some pairs of riders, or doubling and repairing the vessel efficiently and making her sea worthy. - which the owner has declined. -
