New Starboard Louse Pipe, new paul Bitts, new Foremast, five knee & rider bolts renewed in the Hold with metal bolts, also twenty four knee & standard bolts of the Main Deck renewed with metal ones. The ship has been fitted with Iron Tanks for carrying the Telegraph Cable to the Persian Gulf; two sleepers have been fitted in the hold on each side extending fore and aft, from the foremast to nearly the mainmast, bolted through the timbers except eight bolts in each sleeper which are 1 1/2" metal through bolts. Pillars in the Hold have been removed from under eleven beams for the purpose of receiving the Iron Tanks, these beams are supported with chocks on the top of the Tanks.

According to the Log Book the ship was recaulked & resheathed with yellow metal in Calcutta, November 1862; and the appearance confirms this statement.
